Fire Marshal Board Report – April 2025



Permits & Inspections:

About a dozen inspections were carried out in the past month. No major issues to report.

Permitting and plan review is beginning to pick up as the weather warms up.

Projects:

Nederland Water –

Working on synchronizing hydrant data from Town to input into First Due; our intent is to share location and records including maintenance, flow testing, repairs, etc.

Fire Code Update –

Working with Town on cleaning up the IFC amendments for code adoption. We are meeting as a group periodically to keep momentum.

WACK –

Redeveloped our printed maps for emergency polygons with assistance from BCSO GIS; issued updated maps to wildland kits.

Fire Danger Signs –

Working with CDOT, Chief, and others to coordinate new signs. We're hoping to get them in place by late spring/early summer.

Other Activities:

We hosted the quarterly Boulder County Fire Marshal's meeting at Nederland Station 1 this month; thanks to Sherry for hosting a great meeting.

Cistern testing is in full swing, thanks to Mandi and Chuck for their help.

Working with Captain Moran, LtC Mandi Papich to simplify our water supply and resource ordering for structure fires. We've been formulating calculations based on IFC, NFPA, best practices, and our SOGs.
