- Account Balances
  - Savings \$685,814.58
    - Checking \$ 7,189.59
  - Capital Reserves \$ 6,580.22

  - Total Offeserved Funds \$461,456.11
- June 2022 approximately 40k ahead of June 2021
- Total income to date approximately 71% of expected for 2022
  - Tax revenue collected in June expected to show up in July
- ➢ Expenses
  - June: \$9k overspend vs budget

- \$13k command vehicle (unbudgeted)
- \$7k medical advisor (budgeted across the entire year)
- YTD \$24k overspend
- Garage door maintenance & command vehicle have been paid for
- Roof repair, new phone system, burn building (permit & footings), 5631 pump still outstanding
- Keep in mind increasing reserve for operating and payroll to \$190k
- Likely we will tap into reserves February 2023
- Audit: File by July 31<sup>st</sup> with state
  - Auditor will have complete by end of July; however, requires board approval
  - Extension has been filed new deadline Sept 2022
- Chief's Report
  - Roof update: Signature Services returned to reseal some of trouble spots
    - Roof still leaking; 3<sup>rd</sup> time out
    - No warranty on roof repairs just sealing with silicone
    - Previous repair was done improperly & roofer is trying best to seal
  - Bay doors maintenance completed
  - Garage door opener on bay for 5631 broke
    - Garage Doors bid to replace opener: \$2570
    - Opener purchased for \$1200; Charlie will install to save money
  - Phone system complete
  - ➢ 5631 pump & tank ordered (potential contributor to overspend)
    - Underbudget for parts approximately \$12k
  - Community engagement: Read books at library to kids
    - Thanks to Scott P, Mandi P, Charlie for helping
  - Chief Instructed Instructor I in Boulder
  - Lt. Joslin completed Instructor I
  - CDOT signs for district boundaries
    - Advised only use blue & white, no graphics, can't double hang on sign
    - Looking for advisement on how to proceed regarding permit
      - No fee with permit; fee if CDOT used for work
    - Boulder County (BOCO) doing good job with fire ban signs; Forest Service (FS) put new fire ban signs on West Mag
    - 5 points needs new sign
  - District boundaries
    - Meet with Sugarloaf Fire Chief
      - NFPD responds to homes that are SLFPD
      - SLFPD responds to homes that are in our district
      - Homes that are in neither district, who responds?
    - Need additional information from legal counsel regarding rights as district before considering next steps forward
  - ➢ Cisterns
    - Detailed report available from June meeting
      - Cistern fund money question where does it go?
        - To be used to build another community cistern or purchase a tanker (i.e. 5642)
    - Don't maintain private cisterns
      - May want to consider annual inspection program for private cisterns in exchange for use during a fire
    - Fee is outdated (now: \$2500)
      - Research needed to determine appropriate fee schedule (tasked to Fire Marshall Andrew Joslin)

- Will review all fees & bring adjustments requests to board in group
- Apparatus committee
  - Done a great job with recommendations, vehicle checks, planning for future
  - Joint mechanic in discussion with other chief of Timberline & Coal Creek
- > Trainings
  - S130, S190 wildlands & certs completed
  - TIC (thermal imaging camera) training
  - Working with Timberline & Sugarloaf to build training cadre w/departments in area
- > Vehicles
  - New 5624 in service, needs graphics
    - Battery draining, believed to be due to radio going to label so clear need to be shut off
  - Going to sell old 5624 & 5620
    - Contact at Front Range Fire going to help move apparatus

#### • Fire Marshall's Report

- ➢ Fire Code Updates: 2018 IFC Adoption
  - Presented to county fire code review committee, desire minor grammatical changes (changes are highlighted)
    - Don't change meaning
- > Projects
  - Firewood sale during fire bans; can't ban sale of firewood
    - Signs and flyers were made and posted at Ace and B&F
    - Working with firewood supplier for community, agreed to insert flyers into bundles
    - Since program started & FS signs observed reduction in fires in West Mag area
- Future Project: Permanent fire ban for vacation rentals (VRBO, Air B&B)
  - Neighbors concerned, very large fires
  - Potential solutions
    - Permit option: renter come to station & receive education (may be onerous)
    - Inspection option: owner would have to create fire pit that is safe (permanent fire ring, water accessible)
    - Include verbiage in rental agreement about fire safety (flames less than 3 feet, etc)
    - Estes & Chief Wolf have run a successful program (permit the property)
  - Challenges
    - Enforcement & management challenges
  - Renter safety: knowing evacuation routes, receiving alerts (cell service), how notify
  - Current status: No permit/inspection required from NFPD viewpoint
    - Miranda: STR self-inspection form says that homeowner must provide evacuation routes, comply with fire bans, fire extinguishers, etc; town does not inspect on routine basis
    - NFPD larger than town of Nederland; need to work with town & county
- Inspections: forms have been digitized & process has been streamlined, greater throughput of inspections
- $\succ$  Town events
  - Town clean-up & 4<sup>th</sup> of July were successful events
  - National Night Out August 2<sup>nd</sup> in Chipeta Park organized by Nederland Fire District Auxiliary

- Jazz & Wine Festival August 20<sup>th</sup> in Chipeta Park
- ➤ Training
  - Fire Instructor I completed
  - Scheduled 2 ride-a-longs with fire marshals in other districts
  - Identifying appropriate IFSAC Pro Board Fire Inspector I training need to insure certification can come back to state

#### • Additional Points

- > Field training completed for 2 PRN medics; 2 additional medics in training
  - Saves money; don't have to pay time & a half

- Board member as a reserve
  - No Action

#### • Purchasing Policy required updating

- Bid Selection should be holistic
- Bid Discrepancy policy added
- Amount Guidelines adjusted
  - Increases for shift captains and chief without authorization
- Suggest changing by-laws to account for inflation to require public notifications for bids above \$75k; increase from \$25k
- Discussion regarding emergency spending section

#### • Mill Levy Update

- Survey has gone to the printers and will be mailed out next week
- Changed to first class mailing rate
- ▶ Response deadline is August 22<sup>nd</sup>
- > Online survey available, information on website, preparing social media announcement
- Ballot language draft in mailer, can change

#### **New Business**

- Boulder County Ballot Question: Funding for Emergency Response
  - Raise sales tax for emergency response in the county
    - Search and rescue prioritized (Rocky Mountain Rescue)
    - Seems to be way to funding for ambulance contract
    - Special districts seem to be end of line for ballot measure
  - ➢ How will funding be distributed?
  - County did not consult/perform outreach with NFPD
  - NFPD can't collect sales tax w/o restructuring district; require IGA with other entity (i.e. town, county)
- Mill Levy Mailer
  - Responses slow? People may not have checked PO boxes
  - Coalesced addresses so that only one survey sent to a household?
