- Motion to Approve Agenda
 - > Approved 4-0-0
- Motion to approve previous meeting minutes

 - > Account Balances

Total Funds \$420,595 Total Reserves \$203,042.94 Total Unreserved Funds \$240,000

- > Income
 - \$64.5K from tax revenue
 - \$420.00 from donations
 - \$5.5K in wildfire billing
 - \$22K A/R in deployment received most of the funds but not all
- Expenses
 - Showing overspent
 - o Adjustment, UTV is being reallocated to another fund
 - Are we treating the UTV as capital and adjusting for depreciation?
 - Legal fees were high but should decrease (may need to budget higher for next year)
- ➤ Keeping in view
 - Looking good for FEB 23
 - Better accountability for meals (e.g. number of people/meeting purpose)
 - Total of \$116.8K to the positive for FY22

• Chief's Report

- > Action Items
 - Fire Marshal step-pay scale as a result of obtaining certification
 - verbal agreement with Mike Scott not in job offer letter
 - According to HR the District would help pay for them to obtain certifications but were not tied to step increases
 - a pay range is reflected in the position description in Teams
 - All position descriptions (PDs) are lumped into one document and not separated by title/job.
 - Create spreadsheet to show step-pay scale for the Fire Marshal available for the April meeting (Director McElvain & Interim Chief Schmidtmann)
- Follow up
- ➤ Other updates/information
 - Apparatus
 - 5621 Steering box leaking but will be repaired under warranty
 - 5601 Telma brake has malfunctioned, replacing the controller didn't fix it
 - 5617 Needs new tires, generator still not working. Front Range sending up a technician
 - 5630 (UTV) arrived still collecting parts
 - 5652 (Fire Marshal Truck) battery drain and currently at East Street Garage
 - 5632 fuel tank being replaced
 - Badging ceremony scheduled for March 23, 2023
 - Extrication batteries replaced under recall notice (all but 1 received)
 - MES visited for a new SCBA compressor and quoted around \$60K
 - This is high priority as far as FF safety
 - Do we need to push the burn building another year?
 - All the tanks are up for inspection/hydro testing this year which is an additional cost
 - 1B tax allotted for emergency services Districts are asking for a big chunk of that in order to purchase life safety PPE
 - Motion for Interim Chief Schmidtmann (or designee) to get quotes for compressors for purchase according to spending policy 4-0-0
 - Several conferences were paid for by Mike Scott and we are now looking to get things transferred/refunded.
 - FDIC Chief & 3 Captains plan to attend and is supported by the Board
 - Shifts are covered
 - Single family residence request for construction in Boulder County is inaccessible to fire/ems and we may need to consult the lawyer to cover the District.
- Calls of Significance
 - Captain Benson possible structure fire was actually a dishwasher but the team was ready to take action.
 - Fire Marshal conducted an executive summary
 - Accidental and working cause is that it was a part within the dishwasher
 - Rescue for lost snowboarder at the top of Caribou (lost for 29 hours)
 - 4WD ambulance requested and NFPD responded
 - Eldora is experiencing a high number of patient contacts and calls for service
 - Single vehicle MVA involving driver & 4 pets
- Safety/Training
 - 104 hours
 - February 11th forced entry training with TLFD
 - February 25th interagency backcountry rescue training

- Several volunteers completed driver/operator written exams and/or practical
- Interim Chief Schmidtmann completed Fire Officer II
- > EMS
 - EMR class is currently in session with 20 students
 - Transitioning POC roles for several programs
 - Ambulance inspections complete and waiting Boulder County approval
 - EMT application returned by State to revise to remove Mike Scott

• Fire Marshal's Report (presented by Interim Chief Schmidtmann)

- ➤ Attended CCICC Course in Loveland
- ➤ Renewed EMT and CPR with NREMT
- Preparing for fire investigator testing
- Projects
 - Wildland pre-plan creating actionable map areas based on strategy and risk assessment
 - Trying to come up with a plan in regards to address signs needing to be posted at some residences that either have none or need an upgraded/visible one

- > Banking change update
 - Elevations Credit Union credit unions might not be available
 - First National has a lot of things we are looking for
 - Has to be set up as a public funds account to be covered by FDIC

- Resolution 2023-09: Granting Fiscal Management Authority
 - During the transition of Iain Irwin-Powell no longer serving on the Board and Stephanie Cooke not supporting Accounting activities past May 2023.
 - Blanket resolution to present to the bank/organization to allow Sherry Snyder and Jess McElvain fiscal management authority.
 - Motion: 4-0-0
- > FPPA and CO Trust Access
 - Adding Sherry Snyder as signatory and adding dual authorization for movement of funds
 - Guy Falsetti will be dual authorizer
 - Adding Sherry Snyder, Jess McElvain and Todd Wieseler) to FPPA access
- ➤ Fire Chief Search
 - High level search
 - Internal/external job posting
 - Internal job posting
 - Internal interim with possible permanent placement and/or external posting in 6-12 months
 - Do not involve the two Captains that are interested in the position to stay impartial with search criteria
 - Posting does not have a timeframe it must be open for
 - Position description and job posting is the first step to get the right person
 - Qualifications: required v. preferred
 - o Experience with a volunteer department
 - Live in district/response time (live within 25 miles)

- Currently listing within 60 minutes
- o Do you offer a relocation package?
- If we hire internally that will leave a Captain position open and that will need to be posted as well
- Action item: Guy will work with Lucy and the Members of District on the job description and requirements and get it out to the Board March 22nd (special meeting may be required)
- > Executive Coaching
 - Looking at a \$10K cost for the District
 - Should we be doing this when not fully staffed?
- > Triad EAP for Volunteers
 - Done through CEBT (\$2.50/month PP = \$70/month)
 - Need to confirm volunteers spouse and children under 26
 - Is Nicolleti available to volunteers or staff only?
